The Jules Rossman Endowed Scholarship was created by the WIDR Alumni Society to pay tribute to Dr. Jules Rossman, a former Western Michigan University professor of communications as well as a mentor and supporter of WIDR staff.

The scholarship is **open to WIDR staff** who meet the following criteria:

- *Full-time, currently enrolled WMU student (graduate or undergraduate), in good academic standing (as defined by the WMU Financial Aid Office) with at least two semesters work experience at WIDR.*
- *Applicant must be a returning student to WMU in the FALL 2006 semester.*
- *Applicants must submit to the WIDR Alumni Society, a typed, one-page explanation of their service to WIDR, indicating reasons why the applicant is a good candidate for this scholarship and what specifically he or she has done for WIDR lately.*
- *Applicants must submit two (2) letters of endorsement from other WIDR staff members. These letters may be very concise and to the point.*

The scholarship winner will be awarded **\$500 toward WMU tuition, fees or book expenses** for the **FALL 2006** semester.
